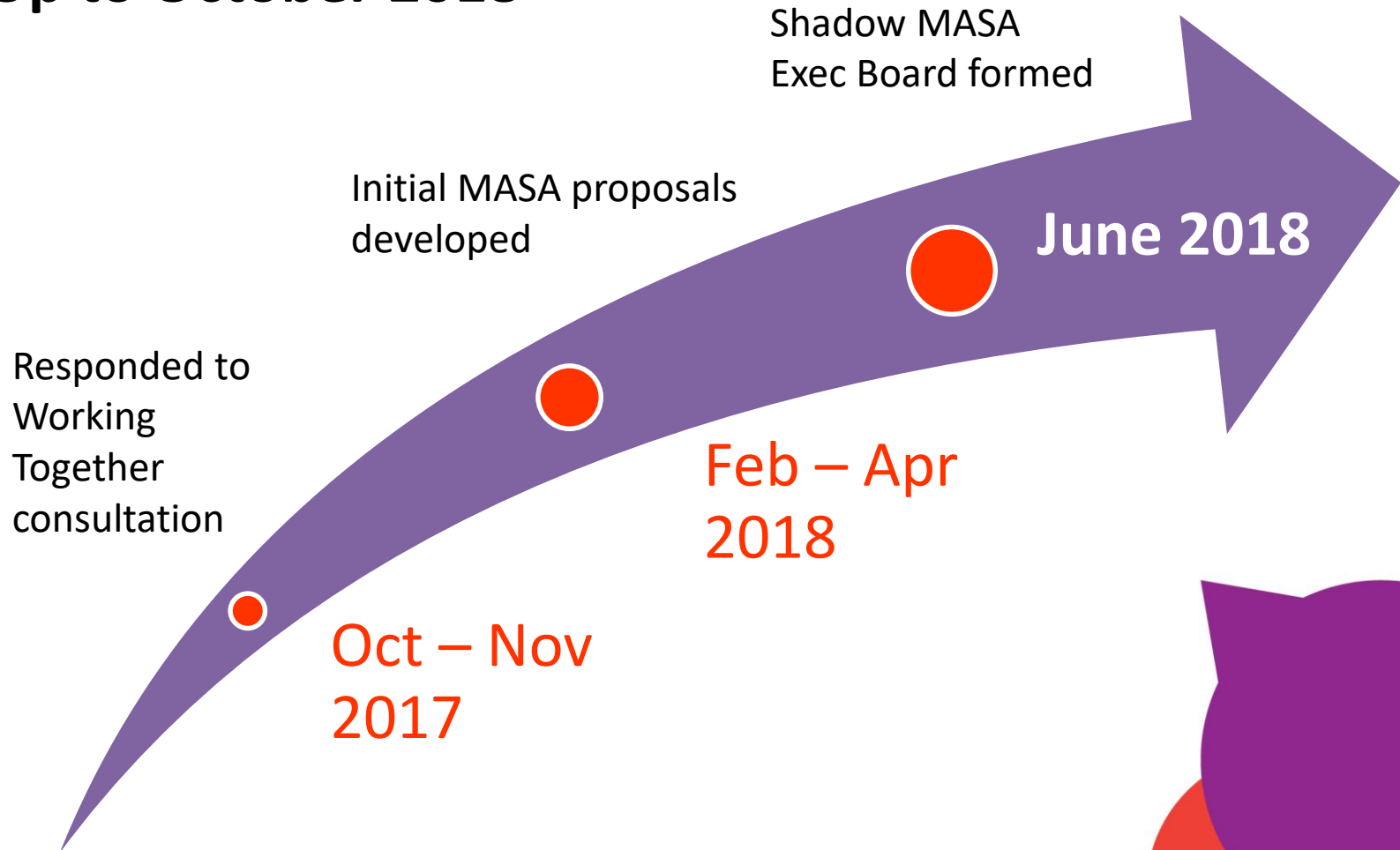
## North Lincolnshire – who are we

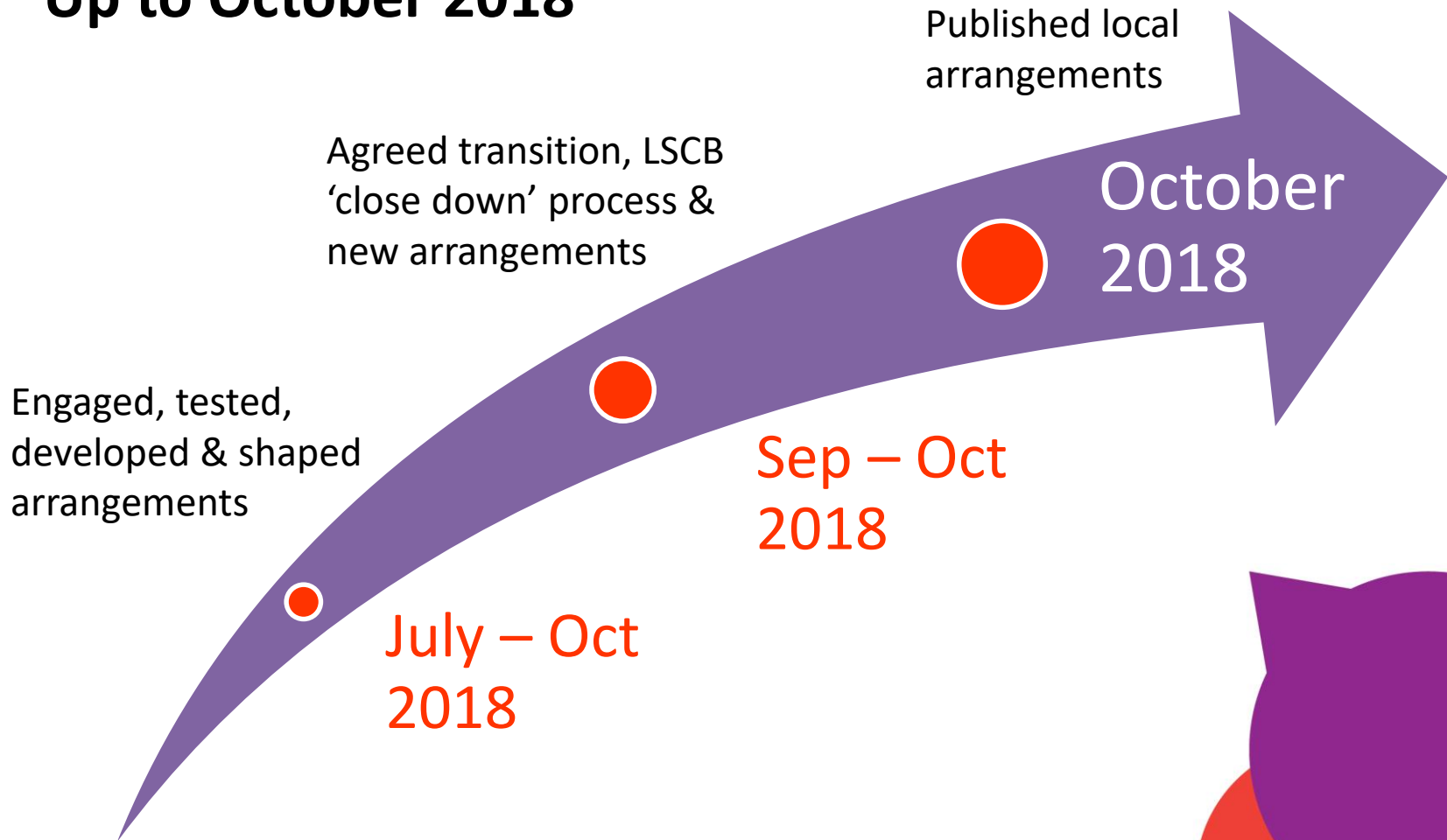

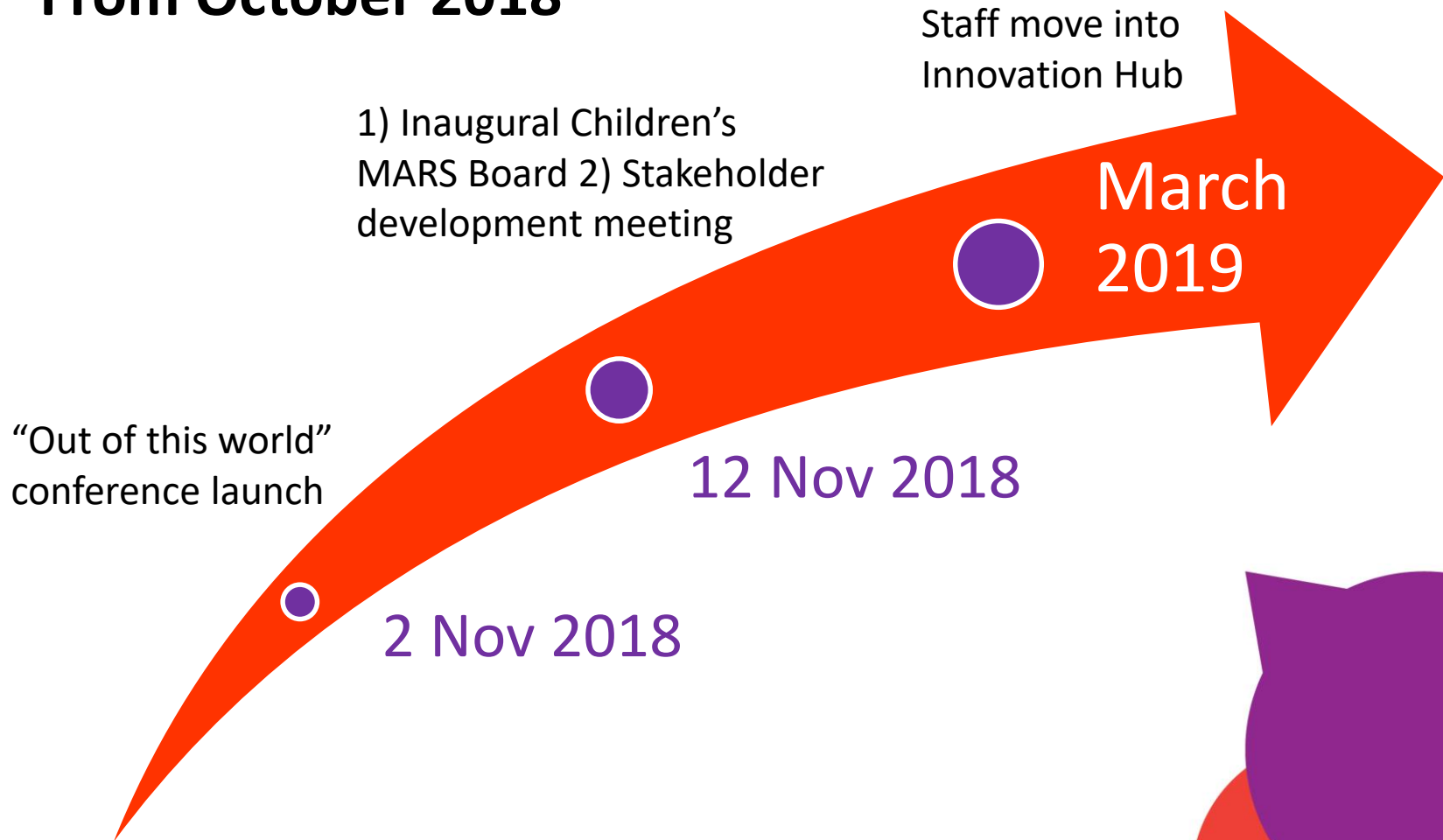

- ✓ Delivery plan to keep on track with implementation
- ✓ Dedicated officer into Multi Agency Innovation Hub from each safeguarding partner organisation
