Domestic Abuse Strategy - 2018/21

CONTEXT

Reducing the harm from domestic abuse is an area of focus for the Children's Multi Agency Resilience & Safeguarding (MARS) Board and reducing the impact of domestic abuse is also one of the key outcomes for the Community Safety Partnership. The Safeguarding Adults Board is also committed to the protection of adults at risk of abuse or neglect.

VISION

The ambition for the Children's MARS Board is that :

The aim of the Safeguarding Adults Board is to:

- integrated, effective whole family approach to address and stop domestic abuse
